**Application for State Discharge Permit 16DP3156, NPDES Permit MD0067482:**

NASA – Goddard Space Flight Center, Code 250, Greenbelt Rd., Greenbelt, MD 20771 submitted an application for renewal of a permit to discharge an average of 32,000 gallons per day of noncontact cooling water, boiler blowdown, and water deionization backwash, and variable volumes of storm water from a research and office facility, located on Greenbelt Rd. at Soil Conservation Rd., Greenbelt, MD, to an unnamed tributary to Beck Branch of Beaverdam Creek (Use I Anacostia tributary) and to an unnamed tributary to Bald Hill Branch, a Tier 2 stream segment (Use I Patuxent River tributary).

If a written request is received by **June 20, 2016**, an informational meeting can be held to discuss the application and permitting process.
